




KANSAS CITY CONVENTION CENTER


Encompassing more than **800,000 square feet**, the Kansas City Convention & Entertainment Facilities can serve all your meeting needs under one roof. The eight-square-block convention and special event facility can accommodate **388,800 square feet** of column-free exhibit space on one floor; 48 state-of-the-art meeting rooms; a 2,400-seat fine arts theater; an arena that seats more than 10,700 people and a unique outdoor festival plaza.

And not only is it all in one location, the complex is connected to major downtown hotels and parking by skywalks and underground walkways. One of America's largest green ballrooms—the 46,484-square-foot Grand Ballroom—is certified LEED silver, boasting waterless plumbing, energy-efficient heating & cooling and one of the most sophisticated lighting systems in the world. That's enough to make other cities turn green with envy.




Street-level amenities include an arena; fine arts theater; outdoor festival plaza and conference rooms.

EXHIBIT HALL

- The hall's 388,800 square feet of contiguous, column-free space allows for more than 2,000 10-by-10 foot booths.
- Four sound-resistant, movable walls can divide the Exhibit Hall into as many as five separate rooms.
- Utility floor ports on 30-foot centers include electrical, telephone and high speed Internet service. Some also include water, gas, air and drains.
- Amenities include high-blower air conditioning, LED lighting with 100 foot-candles and an electronic public address system.
- 300 lb./sq.ft. live floor load.

NOTES:

Boasting **388,800 square feet** of column-free exhibit space on one floor, Bartle Hall truly stands in a category by itself. Bartle Hall connects with major downtown hotels; 1,000 underground parking spaces; Municipal Auditorium and the Conference Center via skywalks and underground walkways. With three truck docks and 22 tractor trailer bays, Bartle Hall reflects its carefully designed versatility and accessibility for both the public and exhibitors.




MEETING ROOMS 2100 & 2200

- 26 meeting rooms encompass more than 62,000 square feet and accommodate more than 6,000 people.
- All rooms are equipped with individual sound systems, high-speed wireless Internet access, simultaneous taping, carpeting and a programmable lighting system that allows for individual control over each light unit.
- Specially-designed board and conference rooms offer built-in credenzas and data-powered A/V equipment.
- Ballroom 2103 features 18,096 square feet; 17-foot ceilings and is divisible into three breakout rooms.
- Ballroom 2103 comfortably seats 1,800 for general sessions and 1,250 for banquets.
- Three separate lobbies provide more than 53,500 square feet of versatile registration and pre-function space featuring a state-of-the-art projection system.
- Multiple banks of escalators, passenger and freight elevators provide easy access to all levels of the facility.



CONFERENCE CENTER & GRAND BALLROOM



The complex's 100+ WiFi access points ensure you are always connected.

The versatile Conference Center complements your function and meeting space options when holding a meeting at the Exhibit Hall or serves as the perfect stand-alone facility for smaller conferences, meetings and special events. The architectural elements of the Conference Center provide a visual link between Bartle Hall and the beautiful Art Deco style of Kansas City's historic Municipal Auditorium. The 40,500-square-foot Grand Ballroom is expandable to **46,484 square feet** for events up to 4,000 people. Its unique interior design celebrates the city's fountains and features a controllable natural lighting system and a glass wall offering dramatic views to the south.

NOTES:

CONFERENCE CENTER

- More than 56,000 total square feet on three levels, seating up to 6,000.
- Space is divisible to up to 19 rooms featuring high-speed Internet connectivity, sound-proof dividing walls, state-of-the-art sound system, variable lighting, individual temperature controls and centralized taping capabilities.
- Features 34,760 square feet of elegant registration or pre-function space that is divisible for up to three offices or breakout rooms to support registration area.
- Barrier free movement with conveniently located escalators, passenger and freight elevators.

GREAT HALL (3501)

- Features 23,910 square feet, 28-foot ceilings and is divisible into eight breakout rooms.
- Comfortably seats 2,250 for general session and 1,650 for banquets.
- Connects via skywalks directly to the exhibit floor level of Bartle Hall and Municipal Auditorium.




GRAND BALLROOM ENTRANCE

GRAND BALLROOM (2501)

- One of the nation's largest eco-friendly ballrooms at 46,484 square feet.
- Features dramatic views to the south of the Performing Arts Center via a 38-foot-high glass wall.
- Divisible into three separate rooms that can be operated independently for greater meeting flexibility.
- Offers a unique, controllable day-lighting system to allow natural light in the space that changes as the sun moves.
- Opens to an outdoor plaza at the southeast corner of the Convention Center complex.
- Connects to the existing Conference Center to accommodate additional breakout rooms.
- Connects to the new Loews hotel via enclosed walkway.



GRAND BALLROOM OUTDOOR PLAZA

MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM



Kansas City's Art Deco Municipal Auditorium complex includes three unique and versatile special event and banquet venues. The Arena seats **10,404**; the Music Hall, one of the nation's finest theaters, seats **2,403**; and the Little Theatre is perfect for more intimate events. Municipal Auditorium connects directly to Level 2 of the Conference Center, to the underground parking garage and downtown hotel walkway system.

LOWER EXHIBITION HALL (The LEX)

- 46,000 square feet of additional space on two levels for exhibitors, catered functions or special events.
- The Hall has its own entrance lobby off 14th Street, is accessible to all parts of Municipal Auditorium and has direct access from the Barney Allis Garage.

MUNICIPAL ARENA

- 7,312 permanent seats; 2,084 seats on risers plus capacity for 1,008 theater-style on main floor.
- Upholstered seating, two large video boards and a sports-lighting system.
- Public amenities include fully-lighted marquee; large box office; 3,600-square-foot foyer; coat check; multiple restrooms and concession stands.
- Heavy all-wooden floor.
- Ramps and elevators facilitate movement of freight throughout the building.

LITTLE THEATRE (ARENA LEVEL)

- Octagon shaped in a gleaming marble façade, the Little Theatre features an exterior promenade, balcony and a permanent stage area.
- With temporary theater seating for up to 400 people and banquet seating for 225, the Little Theatre is perfect for executive dinner parties and intimate special events.

MUSIC HALL

- Opened in 1936, this unique Art Deco theater is the perfect facility for special convention presentations, general sessions or featured entertainment.
- A totally self-contained venue, the Music Hall has its own lighted marquee, box office, main entrance, coat check, restrooms and concessions.
- Total seating capacity is 2,403; with Orchestra seating for 1,207; Loge and Box seating for 278; and Balcony seating for 918.
- Features a spectacular 3,600-square-foot foyer and grand staircase.
- The Music Hall's Art Deco lighting fixtures are the inspiration for the Sky Stations atop Bartle Hall's four pylons.





